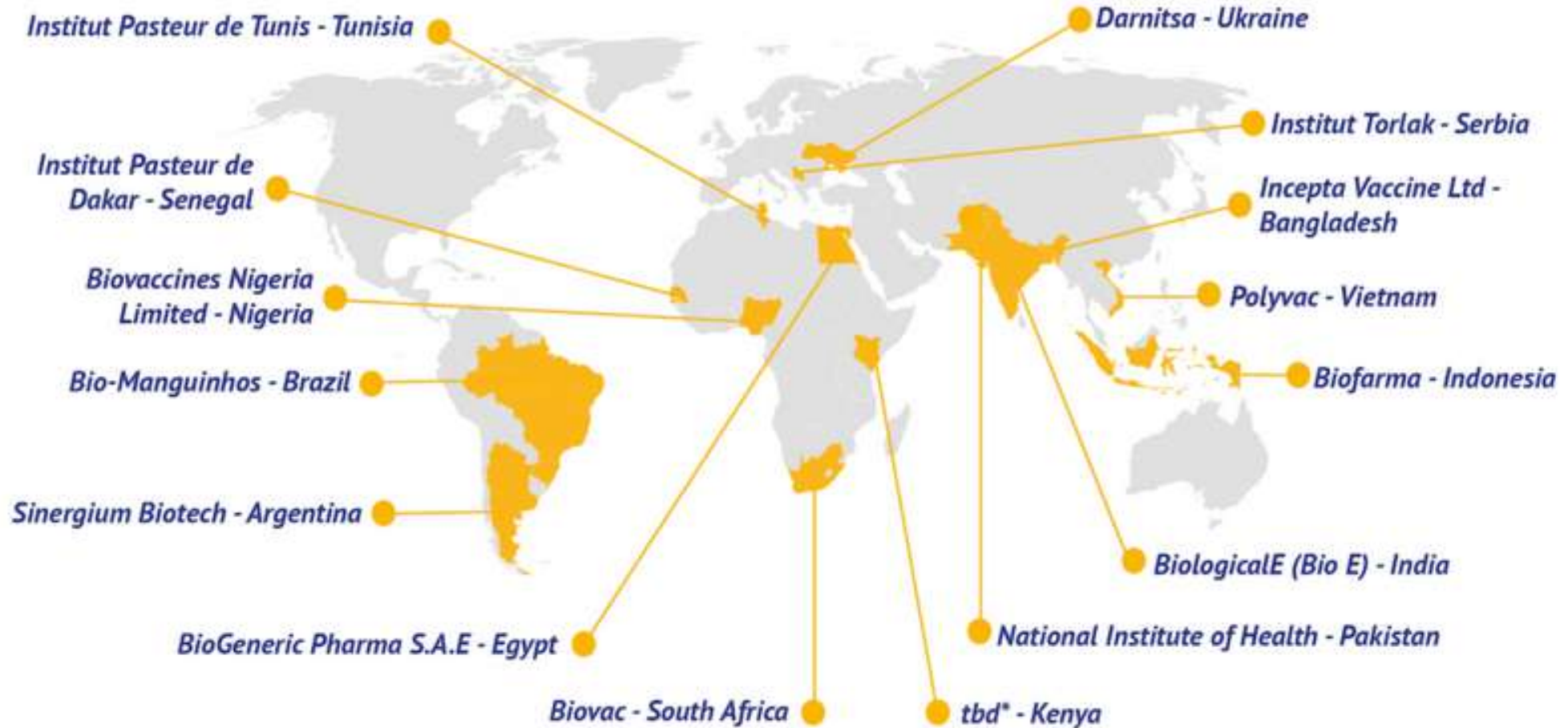
Africa's vaccine manufacturing landscape – operational stakeholders
